



As many are aware, Golf Wichita is an Enterprise Fund. Meaning the golf division has to utilize revenue earned from sales of green fees, cart rentals, food and beverage, gift cards, etc. The profits made during the year are put back into the golf division for upkeep of the golf courses, purchasing equipment, pay staff and make capital improvements. Golf Wichita does not receive tax dollars from the City, County or State.

Being strategic and savvy with how money is spent is something we've had to do. After analyzing the usage of our tee sheets, we've seen a consistent growth in no-shows and overbooking at our four golf courses, costing the Golf Division lost revenue. Not only does this hurt the golf division by a loss of green fees and potential cart rentals, it hurts our customers by limiting available tee times.

Effectively immediately, Golf Wichita will take the following action to prevent no-shows and overbooking:

- Block a customer from booking online after having two or more no-shows that were caused by not showing or overbooking
- Any over booking will result in a no-show per player. Example: Staff will mark a golfer for two no-shows when a golfer books a foursome but only shows with a twosome
- Blocking from online booking will reset on the 1<sup>st</sup> every other month (Jan, Mar, May, Jul, Sep, Nov)
- Staff does not have the ability to alter a customer's account after being blocked, a golfer will have to wait for the next reset date to be able to book online again, no exceptions

As of Thursday, July 15 all golfers have the ability to book online at [golfwichita.com](http://golfwichita.com). Please be diligent in altering your tee times or canceling. Utilizing online booking customers are able to create, edit or cancel tee times, you do not have to wait to call the clubhouse to edit or cancel a tee time.
